### Role Summary

As we are a charity, our work relies heavily on the generosity of our supporters. As an Events Fundraiser, you will be supporting a range of fundraising events in your local area to ensure we can continue to support stroke survivors.

### What tasks this role can include:

- Assisting at event cheering points to support participants.
- Setting up and running stands at events.
- Registering participants at events.
- Acting as route marshals and manning checkpoints at events.
- Helping promote events and activities by putting up posters or distributing leaflets.
- Assisting in promoting events through social media.

- You are friendly, engaging and comfortable meeting and assisting members of the general public.
- You enjoy being a member of a team but are also able to work effectively without direct supervision.
- You enjoy helping to organise social events and local activities for people.
- You are comfortable representing the Stroke Association in public.
